SANTEE FISHING FACTS

Lake Marion is the largest freshwater lake in South Carolina. There is no closed season for fishing in the Santee area. Lake Marion and adjoining – Lake Moultrie hold some pretty impressive records:

- Channel Catfish – World Record **58 lbs.**
- Arkansas Blue Catfish – World Record **109.4 lbs.**
- Striper Bass – State Record **55 lbs.**
- Largemouth Bass – State Record **16.2 lbs.**
- Black Crappie – State Record **5 lbs.**



There are approximately 50 USCG licensed fishing guides available for the inaugural Fins & Skins Event. All individuals must have a South Carolina fishing license.
